### Abtahi Wins Goldwater

For the first time, a SigEp at Miami received a Barry M. Goldwater Scholarship -- the most prestigious award of its type for an undergraduate in mathematics, the natural sciences or engineering.

Amir Abtahi '06 was one of three Miami students and 320 Goldwater Scholars selected nationwide for the scholarship which provides up to \$7,500 per year for college expenses.

A junior zoology major from Nashville, Tennessee, Abtahi has conducted research in several areas of biology. He is currently working on a study of the cellular and molecular mechanisms of retina regeneration in the embryonic chicken.

In addition to being an active member of Sigma Phi Epsilon, Abtahi is also a member of the university honors program, a math and science tutor at the Learning Assistance Center and a volunteer for the Elderly Daytime Care program in Oxford.
